3. Do Not coach your child during the event.
4. Do Not make insulting comments to players, Parents, officials, or coaches of either team.

6. Cheer for your team.
7. Show interest, enthusiasm, and support for your child.
8. Be in control of your emotions.
9. Help when you're asked to be a coach or official.
